Information sheet

Any student who is currently enrolled in one of the programmes listed at the end is eligible to run for a position on the Executive Committee of the EHRAA. The selection for the position will be done by a vote of the rest of the Executive Committee. The term of office is one year, starting 14th November 2011.

The Executive Committee is currently comprised of 12 members: 7 alumni, 1 representative of the Human Rights Centre, 1 PhD student representative, 2 current students, and the Director of the Human Rights Centre.
